
#### **George and Dorothy Hodel interviews**

### TIMELINE OF EVENTS

Feb. 15 1950- DA Lt. Jemison Interviews George Hodel at Hall of Justice while DA sound lab technicians secretly install microphones in

March 22 1950- DA Lt. Jemison interviews <u>Dorothy Hodel at her residence on Santa Monica pier</u>. Shows her pictures of Elizabeth Short and nude photos of George Hodel with Black singer/model, Mattle Comfort. Jemison informs Dorothy that he has witnesses connecting Short and Hodel who also place the victim at the Franklin House prior to the murder. Jemison also confronts Dorothy with reported conversation and statements made by an intoxicated, George Hodel to Dorothy the day after murder where he allegedly told her, "They will never be able to prove I did that murder." (See below original transcribed interview of Dorothy Hodel.)

23, 1950- Dorothy Informs George of Jemison Interview and photos. Mar. 25- George Hodel flees Franklin residence

Mar 23, 1950 - Dorothy Hodel recorded on DA tapes as being present at the Franklin House. (Obviously, she would have Informed George of Lt. Jemison's interview of her the day prior, and that she was shown photographs of Elizabeth Short and Mattle Comfort and that police know of his connections/acquaintances to both women.)

Mar 26, 1950 George on tape overhead talking to "Baron", foilowing verbatim transcribed entries by DA investigator manitoring conversation:

> "Hodel sounds afraid. ... Hodel say's something about Black Dahlia. "Baron mentions FBI. Sounds like Hodel wants to get out of the country. Mentions passport. Hodel talking about picture police have of him and some girl... Thought he had destroyed all of them."

Mar. 27, 1950, (the day after the above conversations)- GEORGE HODEL FLEES FRANKLIN RESIDENCE FORCING END TO DA'S ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE.

Q Where is she living now, what city? A I believe Sen Francisco, but I'm not sure.

Q You are familiar, are you with the trial that Dr. Hodel just went through in connection with Tamara?

A I kno w about it, but I didn't attend it.

Q Do you know Lillian Lenorak? A Yes, I do.

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C When did you first become acqueinted with her, about what year?

A I think it was about 1940. Let me see, say '46. I'm not really sure.

When did you last see her?

A Just before the went to Cemerillo and just before her mother came for her. nyway, after shw was ill over there at George's.

n C Do you know her mother?

0 When you last saw her did you feel she was a mental case, is that what your information is?
A I felt she must be. The little boy was running around and was very distressed. Four little kid.

16 Q I will now show you a photograph of Beth Short, Santa Barbara No. 11419 and ask you whether or not you have ever seen that young ledy in your life?
A No, I never have.

G Did you have a conversation with Dr. Hodel about the murier of Beth Short?

A No, unless we mentioned it when it was in the papers, but I don't like to read about things like that. I can't say for sure that I have never mentioned her name to him, but it may have been in passing.

21 Q Did he ever tell you, "They can't pin that murder on ma?"
A No, to the best of my knowledge he didn't and doesn't
22 know her.

23 G On or about the date of her murder, January 15, 1947
do you remember being out until 4:00 in the morning with George
24 Hodel and coming in slightly intoxicated? Now, that's three
years ago.

Q A Well, I think I explained before we never went on arinking perties because I don't drink because of certain tendencies to drink too much and particularly if I were near him I would not drink because from a medical point of view he does not approve of my drinking and I don't know that I understood that question.

- Q Well, the information that I have is that he was quite intexleated himself and at that time on that occasion stated that they couldn't pin the Black Dahlie murder on him. A No. No, that isn't true.
- Q Do you remember ever telling Tamar that? A Ro.
- Q Did you ever tell Tamar that Dr. George Hodel was out the night before the murder with Beth Short at & party? ". No. I was living at my brother's house at the time. We 8 were not living at the same house. I wouldn't know what he was doing. 9
  - O What was your brother's address at that time? A 2121 Loma Vista Place.
  - Q Mas envoody ever told you that Dr. George Hodel had Beth Short over to his home? A No.
  - Q Nobony has ever told you that? A No No one has ever told me that.
  - G For your information has photograph has been identified by certain persons as resembling the young lady that was over to his house orior to the murner. You never heard anything about thet?

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- 18 Q is a matter of fact you are on quite a friendly relation bren't you, with Dr. George Hodel? 10 A We are friends.
  - 2 And at the time of this murder, which was so publicated and made headlines in the newspaper at that time, weren't You on pretty friendly terms with him? A We have always been on friendly terms.
  - Q That was Jenuary 15, 1947 three years and two months aga.
- I'm trying to relate it to when he got back from China. Was that before or after he got back from Chine?
- 25 Q It was sometime after he got back from China. It was st a time when Dr. George Hodel had a madical clinic on East 交換 First Street, near Central Avenue. A He had the clinic for a long time before he left.

Q Let's go beck to the time and do you remember at that time of Dr. Hodel having noon lunch or dinner at the Biltmore? A No.

3 Q Did you ever have lunch with Dr. Hodel at the Biltmore?
A I imagine so.

C Would you know it to be a fact that Dr. Hodel did eat lunch or dinner on occasion at the Biltmore?

A He has taken me to lunch there once or twice and we have had dinner there perhaps.

Q For your information we know of other women that have had lunch with him at the Biltmore Hotel and dinner. A It's a central location.

Q There is further information that Dr. Hodel stayed at the Biltmore hotel on a few occasions. Do you remember those?

A I believe when he was between apartments when they had that three-day low in effect, he stayed I believe. I'm not sure. I think the Biltmore was among them. He made a tour of the hotels and stayed three days in each while he was finding an apartment.

Q You understand that a very serious crime has been committed here and the District ittorney would not like it if you were to withhold any information in connection with a murder of this type and we would like to have you give us any and all information you may have in connection with this murder on this suspect George Hodel. If there is anything you have to tell us, tell us.

A I have nothing to tell you that would bear out any idea you may have that he did this. All I know is that he is not the sort of man that would psychologically be the kind to do it. He has a fine record as a doctor and is a dedicated man. He has never had a fashionable practice. He could have had. He is a man that really cares about medicine, not of earning money, but it is incredible to me that he should be in any way connected with it.

You know that Dr. Hodel has had practice with surgical tools?

A I know he has neverprecticed surgery. His branch of medicine is V. D. generally and Administrative Medicine.

Q I show you Sheriff's Photograph B 113364 and will ask you is you recognize that? A Yes.

Who is that?

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Q Now in view of the fact that the District Attorney's office is interested in contacting all persons that might know something about whether or not Dr. Hodel had anything to do with this murder, I now show you a photograph of a nude girl and ask you if you recognize who that girl is. In other words, we want to know her name and where we can contact her?

There is something familiar about her face. I think she may have been some model or something.

Q Would you say she is a colored girl or half Indian, do you know?
A No.

Q Would you know who the photographer might be in connection with this picture?

A No.

Q I show you another photograph of the same girl with a men. Do you recognize that men in that photograph?
A I would say that was Dr. Hodel.

C Do you know the person who owns the cat that they are bolding between them?

No, I don't.

Q In other words, I am sincerely interested in contacting this girl for information.
No, I don't know her. I have seen her face. I have seen photographs that George has of her.

Q Would you have any idea where we could find her?

Q I show you the third picture. Dr. Hodel and the colored girl. You still can't place any person that might know where I can find her?

A No. I don't know. I can't think.

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Q Did you ever hear Dr. Hodel say anything more about the jetails of this murier of Beth Short about the body or anything about it?

No, I never heard him discuss it at all.

No, I hever heard him discuss it at all.

Well, if you look back on the events that took place about the time of the murder, did you have any reason to suspect that Dr. Model might have had something to do with it? A None whatever.

Q Let me advise you that we do have information that he did associate with Beth Short and as you know the last place she

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was seen alive was at the Biltmore Hotel in the evening 1 of January 9, 1947. A I didn't know that. Q You are positive at this time that you never met that girl? Very very sure. Q What is the name of your attorney? 1. Hobert Butts. Б And what is his address? It's the Bank of America Building at Hollywood and Ivar. I forget the number. 7 Q Did he savise you to give a statement to the District 8 Attorney's office? A Yer. 41 10 Q He did request however that you get a copy of the statement is that right? 11 A That's right. 12 And as I have stated before, that's something the District Attorney has never done in connection to giving copies to any 13 witnesses at any time.
